 4—3” Chenille Bumps—White
 2—3” Chenille Bumps—Pink
 Whiskers
 1—4” Straw Hat
 1—2 1/2” Pom Poms—White
 3—1/2” Pom Poms—Pink

Materials Needed:

Wire Cutters
 Glue

Directions:

Creating Pins: To add beads to the safety pins, hold one opened pin with the point facing away and up. Add beads as shown in the table at the bottom. Begin putting beads on the pin, starting with the beads listed on the bottom and working your way to the head of the pin. **PLEASE NOTE:** Beads should appear in the same order as shown below. (Make sure to create the number of pins needed of each type, & keep pins separate. 64 pins total.)

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<p>“A” Pin (#4) (Make 32)</p>	<p>“B” Pin (#2) (Make 30)</p>	<p>“C” Pin (#2) (Make 2)</p>

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Step 1. Cut your wire into 3—12” and 2—14” pieces.

See Diagram on next page for wiring pins.

Row 1: Starting at the bottom of the bunny. Using 12” of wire, * thread wire through bottom loop of 1- “A” Pin, add 1—10mm Faceted Bead. Repeat from * until 16- “A” Pins and 16—10mm Faceted Beads have been used. Pull Tight. Twist and cut off excess wire.

Row 2: Using 14” of wire, * thread wire through the head of 1- “A” Pin (from previous row), add 1—8mm Faceted Bead, then thread wire through bottom loop of 1 loose “A” Pin, add 1—8mm Faceted Bead. Repeat from * until 16- “A” Pins, and 32—8mm Faceted Beads have been used. Pull Tight. Twist and cut off excess wire.

Row 3: Using 14” of wire, * thread wire through the head of 1- “A” Pin (from previous row), add 1—Rondell, then thread wire through bottom loop of 1- “B” Pin, add 1—Rondell. Repeat from * until 16- “B” Pins, and 32 Rondells have been used. Pull tight. Twist and cut off excess wire.

Row 4: Using 12” of wire, thread wire through head of 1- “B” Pin (from previous row), add 1—6mm Faceted Bead, then thread wire through the bottom loop of 1- “C” Pin, add 1—6mm Faceted Bead, then thread wire through the head of 1- “B” Pin (from previous row), add 1—6mm Faceted Bead, then thread wire through the bottom loop of 1- “B” Pin (loose), add 1—6mm Faceted Bead, then thread wire through head of 1- “B” Pin (from previous row), add 1—6mm Faceted Bead, then thread wire through bottom loop of 1- “B” Pin (loose), add 1—6mm Faceted Bead, then thread wire through head of 1- “B” Pin (from previous row), add 1—6mm Faceted Bead, then thread wire through the bottom loop of 1- “C” Pin, add 1—6mm Faceted Bead. Continue until all 14- “B” Pins, 2- “C” Pins, and 32—6mm Faceted Beads have been used. Pull tight. Twist and cut off excess wire.

Row 5: Using 12” of wire, thread wire through the head of 1- “B” Pin, add 1—6mm Faceted Bead. Repeat from * until 16—6mm Faceted Beads have been used. Pull tight. Twist and cut off excess wire.

Step 2: Glue Hat

Step 3: Glue 1—White Pom Pom on the back for tail, then glue 1—Pink Pom Pom for nose, and 2—Pink Pom Poms for mouth. Put whiskers between the nose and mouth.

Step 4: To make ears, count 2—White Chenille Bumps, cut off, bend in the middle. Cut 1—Pink Chenille Bump and put that in the middle of the 2—White Chenille Bumps. Glue, then place on the side of the hat for ears. Repeat the other side.
