

#JF514 Lace and Tri Bead Snowflake

Materials Included in Kit:

336—Tri Beads—Crystal
108—Rondells—Crystal
72—8mm Faceted Beads—Crystal
9—Chenille Stems—White
6 Yards Beading Lace—White

Materials Needed:

Ruler
Scissors
Glue



Directions

Step 1: Cut the chenille stems in half. You will use three of these 6” stems to make 1 snowflake. Find the middle of two of the stems, lay one across the other and twist together once to secure. Find the middle of another chenille stem and attach it to these two, forming a total of six spokes. Cut Beading Lace into 6—1 yard pieces.

Step 2: Using one chenille spoke, string 1—Rondell, 1—8mm Faceted Bead, 1—Tri Bead, 1—8mm Faceted Bead, and 1— Rondell. Thread chenille stem through the first large hole of the beading lace, add 1—Tri Bead and go through the next large hole of the lace. Continue in this manner until you have used 8— Tri Beads, ending with the lace. Cut the excess lace. Add 1—Rondell Bead. Repeat this step for the remaining five spokes.

Step 3: Loop one chenille stem to form a hanger. Cut the excess chenille stems on the remaining spokes. Glue a Tri Bead in the center of both sides of the snowflake.

Repeat steps 2 and 3 for the remaining 5 snowflakes.
